





Louise Cournarie Pianist, harpsichordist Music Educator Doctor of Piano from the Royal Academy of Music

Pianist Louise holds a doctorate in piano performance from the Royal Academy of Music. She teaches at the Royal Academy of Music and is also a music lecturer at King's College London. She is also a visiting professor at Winchester College. Louise is an expert in European Baroque music. She holds music lectures and master classes in many European countries every year to share and teach young pianists.


Louise plays piano and harpsichord, her performance is very distinctive, and she is considered to be a very creative new generation pianist. Louise has held solo concerts in many famous concert halls around the world, such as the famous Wigmore Hall, St. Martin's Hall, Royal Festival Hall, St. Smith's Hall, Duke Hall, Maison De Radio Hall in France, etc.

Louise studied with piano master Racha Arodaky in Paris, with piano masters Charles Owen and Katya Apekisheva at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, with piano master Ian Fountain at the Royal Academy of Music, and with harpsichordist Maggie Cole and Carole Cerasi.

Soprano, Master of Royal Academy of Music Advanced Artist Diploma

Soprano Ally graduated from the Royal Academy of Music, where she was awarded the Jessie Sumner Scholarship with distinction and the Fernside Prize for her contribution to music.

Ally is an Associate Artist of the Opera cohort 2023, working with the Royal Opera Company on production and landscape projects. She sings a wide range of material in concert, from classical soprano to classic pop songs.

Ally has sung the role of Queen of the Night in The Magic Flute and has performed excerpts from several roles in operatic settings, including the Countess in The Marriage of Figaro, Donna Anna in Don Giovanni and Alcina. Ally has performed in concerts of operatic settings, including Violetta in Verdi's La Traviata and Adina in Donizetti's L'Elisir d'Amore.

Ally is also an Opera Prologue Young Artist, performing in productions of Ethel Smythe's The Wrecker, Poulenc, and other music.

Ally also writes her own songs and has recently released a new solo album, In Plain Sight. She is also the social media editor for Classic FM, creating content for its popular music social media platform. She also works with the company "Hi Lo Singers" to record commercials and sing songs at major sporting events.
